Dear Pastor and Friends,

I'm not sure if time is speeding up, or if I am slowing down. Well, it seems like both are happening... 8 months of 2025 already gone! It hardly seems possible that it's been over twenty-five years ago that we were getting things in order to move our family into the heart of Mexico where we hoped to be used by God for souls, at least as effectively as we were privileged to do so in our home church those many years ago. And yes, God has blessed and used us exceedingly abundantly. Way beyond our hopes and dreams. But we're not done yet! I am a firm believer in the premise that if the Lord grants you another day, then it's because He has something for you to do!

With this thought, we'll try to fill you in with what we've been allowed to accomplish in the last two months...

We mentioned in our last letter that by God's grace, we shipped nearly 2 million portions of scripture into Mexico just as the month of June was wrapping up. Well, along with the larger shipments, we experience a regular flow of individuals who come to get relatively smaller quantities for distribution across the border, adding another 350,000-400,000 pieces of scripture being sent across the border since our last letter. As we write this letter, we are awaiting a brother who comes at least once or twice a month for material. He will collect about 40,000 booklets along with a few boxes of Bibles and a good number of tracts to bring to churches in northern Mexico.

While this is going on, **the Madagascar project**, which is a shipping container of soul winning material for a good missionary over there, is under way. A printing ministry has undertaken the printing of John/Romans booklets, being between 100,000 and 200,000 of those. Along with the booklets, we'll work on gathering gospel tracts in large quantity, and if we can find them, Sunday school and discipleship materials as well. **Please keep this project in prayer!** We must find and gather the needed literature, and then of course, raise the necessary funds with which to ship the container to Madagascar.

Speaking of containers, we are expecting the delivery in the next few days, of the necessary scripture to complete what is needed for the long-awaited shipment to Guatemala which is planned for late in October. We have been wrestling with this project since last spring, but it appears to be finally coming together. Again, **your prayers are of tremendous value** for this effort. The container will carry 2,000,000 + pieces of gospel literature, which can easily account for at least 20,000 souls turning to Christ, at a 1% return on our investment, (though we're confident that our gracious Father in heaven can do much more than 1%!)

We are planning, with the Lord's help, on doing at least 2 more large shipments of scripture into Mexico before the year is over. We so very much want to get the message of hope in Jesus Christ to as many people as we can, just as quickly as we can!

As far as our tract distribution work in the market goes, the number of people showing up is weekly increasing once again, (after the I.C.E. scare). We're numbering in the thousands of tracts and booklets being distributed each month once again, and occasionally people stop to talk, resulting in at least eight salvation decisions in August alone. Between our weekly volunteers and myself we are placing gospel literature into the hands of as many as possible, most of whom accept it gratefully. We consistently meet other believers there also, who ask for quantities to take with them, which they then distribute on both sides of the border. What a blessing!

We would also like to encourage you dear friends, to **keep praying for my wife, Gloria**. She has not yet completely healed from her fall last spring, and though she has gone through 2 months of therapy, the specialist felt the need to perform a procedure where he put her to sleep and 'forced' her knee to bend completely, which now leads to another month or so of therapy. She is a tough lady, but this has been very trying and difficult for us both, not to mention painful for her and very time consuming. Please consider that it very well could be **your prayers which make all the difference!**

As is ever the case, we wish to express our deep gratitude to each and every one of you who lift both ourselves, and this great ministry up in prayer. Without you we cannot imagine doing any of this. Yes, I know that it is the Lord that is making it all happen, but He is using each of you to accomplish His will in reaching so many thousands with the words of mercy and grace! Thank you!!
