Dear Pastor and Friends,

It has been a rough couple of months with the Iran war situation, rising prices on basically everything, as well as numerous other difficulties directly and indirectly related to these things. But God is greater and far above all these crazy happenings, and He is neither shocked nor surprised by any of this crazy stuff going on around us!

Hopefully, you are aware from our previous letter of a couple months ago, the Mexican government made a number of changes to their importation regulations, which has delayed the shipments of large quantities of scripture across the border. However, God is so much greater, and we are slowly seeing resolutions to this situation.

Recently we were blessed to be able to help get two loads of scriptures across the border for distribution, and we are now putting together two more loads of scripture for shipment into Mexico. As I had mentioned previously, the difficulty is not on our side of the border, but rather it's a number of new requirements for the churches and ministries receiving the scriptures. They now have quite a few details that must be authorized by their government, which supposedly will allow them to receive these Bibles, tracts, etc. Many of our contacts in Mexico are, of course, working on this, but it's slow going. Apparently, many of the government employees are unfamiliar with these new rules, confusing things greatly.

By God's grace, we've learned a couple of workarounds, which is how we got the two loads in last month. One of the upcoming loads will be using another workaround, which is quite convoluted, but will let us get the job done. Some more exciting news is that we are putting together a load for **a new distribution center near Cancun, Mexico**. With the diligent efforts of various people and pastors, we believe that they have all of the required paperwork in order, awaiting a final confirmation from the broker's office. We're anticipating that this new distribution center will help supply the needed scriptures to the southeast region of Mexico, meeting an undeniable need in that area. Please help us pray that this all goes smoothly!

On another note, we were blessed to be able to help a missionary family moving to the Guadalajara area of Mexico. Their household articles were delivered to us here at our warehouse, then without too very much difficulty, got the paperwork in order to have it all shipped down to the home they had rented. This was made much simpler due to the missionary having national residency in Mexico instead of just a visa like so many missionaries. I am sure that the wife and children especially were very happy to have all their personal belongings, toys, furniture, etc. there in the new home, making the change much easier for them.

Even though things have started out slow with the shipping problems, our constant need for more space hasn't slowed down. If anything, it has increased! A couple years back, we asked for prayer from y'all regarding adding to our building. We received a couple extra offerings, especially one large offering from a long-time supporting church, which allowed us to expand our building by 375 square feet. This has helped us tremendously, but because of the growth and demand for scripture, along with trying to help missionaries as we're able, it's just not enough. **Will you pray, and then consider an extra offering or two?** I have a very generous quote of approximately \$18.00 a square foot, including the cement work and a completed steel building. Our goal is to add 2,000 square feet of warehouse space, if the Lord will provide. Please, keep in mind that you are a part of this ministry in a very real sense. **To God belongs the glory, but He builds through His people!**

Some personal mentions, if I may... This past weekend we were privileged to drive up to San Antonio for a Saturday birthday party for one of our grandsons, Nathaniel. He turned 10 this past Monday, but the party was Saturday so most of our family could attend. The best part was staying over for Sunday so that we could watch as Nathaniel got baptized! He has trusted Christ quite a while back, but his momma, (my second daughter), wanted to wait for a while to be sure he truly understood what he was doing. Needless to say, we were thrilled about all of this.

Also, as many of you know, my wife's health situation has been a bit of a roller-coaster ride these last few years, but she seems to be doing very well consistently, so for those of you who've been praying for her... **THANK YOU!** Now, because your prayers are obviously bearing fruit, I'll venture to ask prayer for myself. I underwent a surgical procedure in early March, and as a result was sort-of laid-up for a couple weeks. I am doing well now, and it seems to have cleared up a problem I had been dealing with for about 15+ years. I ask prayer mostly because much of our work here is of a physical nature, and were I not able to do the work... well it would do serious damage to this ministry. So, while praying for us, pray the Lord to send a younger, healthier man with a burden to get God's Word into the hands of desperately needy people. THEN, should the Lord decide to shut me down, the work would continue! Share this need with your church, your prayer groups, or just anybody who will intercede on our ministry's behalf.

We are, and will always be greatly indebted to each of you for your faithful support in prayer and finances.
