Dear Pastor and Friends,

2 Cor. 9:10, *Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness.* This passage came to mind as I began to write this letter. This is what we do, we minister seed to the Sowers! And in spite of the legal difficulties in getting truck loads of Scripture across the border, we have been blessed to be able to get a few loads across so far, Hallelujah!

About ten days ago, we sent a load of around 1,000,000 portions of Scripture into Mexico. This included 4 pallets of whole Bibles, another of New Testaments and hundreds of thousands of Bible portions and tracts. As I have so often mentioned, assuming a very conservative estimate of productivity at a one percent return, or to better explain, believing that one percent of those Scriptures will produce a soul receiving salvation... well my friends, that would be **10,000 souls from just that one load!!**

Now, along with this afore mentioned load, we had the privilege of helping a similar ministry get three more loads of Scripture across. This ministry grew out of our work about four years ago, so indirectly, you helped that ministry come into being through your support and prayers. They are shipping 4-6 six loads a year into Mexico. We have been blessed to send 8-9 loads, or more, each of the last few years, at least until this year when the Mexican customs made all of their changes. The load we sent the other day had to be done through a convoluted system of paper trails and permits, but the Lord helped us make it happen! We have another full load palletized, inventoried and weighed, awaiting a final necessary document to supply a considerable number of missionaries and pastors in southeast Mexico. This would cover the states of Campeche, Yucatan, Quintana Roo, and likely reaching on into Tabasco and Chiapas as well.

We're still working with a local pastor in Michoacan, (southwest Mexico), as he struggles to get then needed paperwork completed. Getting permits, etc. from the Mexican government is extremely confusing and difficult. Please pray for the numerous pastors and missionaries who are trying to meet the new governmental regulations so that we can continue to provide them with God's precious word! There are many people in positions of power who are opposed to what we're doing, BUT GOD IS GREATER than them all!! Truly my friends, **your prayers and support are making a difference!** Keep up the great work you're doing!!

We continue to get smaller quantities of Scripture into Mexico through individuals who carry it across in personal vehicles, which are not hindered like a semi-trailer would be. One such brother, Jose, has picked up three pallets of Scripture over the last two weeks alone. That's 225 boxes with over 400 pieces in each box, or better expressed as over 94,000 portions of Scripture! There have been others who just fill up their trunk or van a couple times a month. God's word continues to go out so that souls may come in!

And, of course, we're still active at the Flea Market each weekend. On a slow day we distribute hundreds of tracts and booklets, but very often into the thousands. This also gives us the opportunity for personal work. This past weekend saw seven salvation decisions, the week before there were three, and we consistently realized 10-15 decisions for Christ each month. As we minister seed to the Sower, we also sow the seed wherever possible. **What a privilege we have!!**

On another note, the container of Scripture going to Madagascar has yet to be shipped. All the materials are staged and waiting. We are being helped in this endeavor by a companion ministry in Indiana, which I am sure will inform me as soon as it gets loaded. We haven't pressed for the reasons as to why the delay, preferring to just pray and trust in our all-knowing, all-powerful God to bring this effort to fruition. He knows what's going on, and ultimately, He alone can advance His ministry. He does however, expect us to pray... So please continue to do so with us.

A final thought of praise → Gloria and I have been enjoying good health for quite a while now by God's grace. The surgery I had in March continues to be of benefit, and Gloria has more good days than bad, praise the Lord!!

Once more, **thank you for your consistent prayers and financial support.** YOU, in partnership with us, and by God's grace are making all of this happen! May God richly bless you for all you do for Him!
